MENTORING:

Creating a Meaningful Transition into the Field of Orientation & Mobility

SUPERVISION v. MENTORING

- **Supervisor**-Boss, sage, chief, administrator, superintendent, overseer

One directional/hierarchical view.

- **Mentor**-Teacher, guide, leader, advisor, supporter, director, friend
Provides opportunities for growth/self-confidence



Mentoring has less to do with showing others what you can do then helping them understand what they can do.

RELATIONAL MENTORING

- Word mentor has shifted from noun to a verb.
- Human development does not occur through individualization but through connection with others.
- Core value is TRUST!



INQUIRY

Listen deeply and inquire further, allowing for a different perspective.



VULNERABILITY

Share experiences that make you vulnerable.



RECIPROCAL

Relationship has to be both ways, not one sided.
